



# ATHERFIELD BAY HOLIDAY VILLAGE

CASE STUDY

EEES were engaged to undertake a Phase 1 environmental assessment, Asbestos Survey, Ecological survey and geotechnical site investigation for the redevelopment of Atherfield Bay Holiday village on the south west of the Isle of Wight.

Further works included the completion of a Phase 2 assessment, remediation strategy and remediation of the site including liaison with the local EHO and planning departments to ensure satisfaction of the associated planning conditions.

EEES also designed and installed a set of Owl nesting stations positioned around the site to provide suitable habitats for nesting of these rare birds.

EEES will continue to be involved in this project with ongoing monitoring of the owl boxes and coastal erosion survey monitoring works.
